The four young musicians from Leipzig were enthusiastically welcomed at festivals in Saint Chartier (F), Kaustinen (FIN), Falun (S) and Roskilde (DK). They received the Folkförderpreis in Rudolstadt (D) and were nominated for the „Eiserner Eversteiner“ (Germany’s only European folk award) and have won the „creole 2007 - Prize for Worldmusic from Germany“.
